**Local Government Certification for New VPDES Permitted Landfills**

## **Summary:**

The 2006 General Assembly enacted legislation (SB 106) which requires applications for new or modified VPDES permits (both individual and general) for new municipal solid waste landfills that discharge stormwater directly or indirectly into a local watershed protection district (that was established and designated as such by city ordinance prior to January 1, 2006) to contain a certification from the local governing body that the discharge is consistent with the city's ordinance that established and designated the local watershed protection district in order for the application to be considered complete. This requirement does not apply to any municipal solid waste landfill that was in operation on or before January 1, 2006. This requirement goes into effect on July 1, 2006.

### Disclaimer:

This document is provided as guidance and, as such, sets forth standard operating procedures for the agency. However, it does not mandate any particular method nor does it prohibit any particular method for the analysis of data, establishment of a wasteload allocation, or establishment of a permit limit. If alternative proposals are made, such proposals should be reviewed and accepted or denied based on their technical adequacy and compliance with appropriate laws and regulations.

The 2006 General Assembly enacted legislation (SB 106) that requires local government certification for new or modified VPDES municipal solid waste landfill permits that discharge stormwater into local watershed protection districts. The full text of the Act is given below. Note that the stormwater runoff discharge (direct or indirect) must be into a local watershed protection district that was established and designated as such by city ordinance prior to January 1, 2006. The City of Chesapeake has established such a district for the Northwest River; there may be others.

This Act applies to both new and modified individual VPDES permit applications and to new and modified coverage under VPDES general permits. The permit application or registration statement cannot be considered complete without this local government certification. The Act does not apply to any municipal solid waste landfill that was in operation on or before January 1, 2006.

This requirement goes into effect on July 1, 2006. The requirement will be added to the VPDES Permit Manual in the next update.

An example certification form is attached; however, it is not a requirement that an applicant use this form. Three sample letters are also attached: (1) for permittees requesting new or modified individual permit applications; (2) for permittees requesting new or modified coverage under a general permit; and (3) for individual applications or general permit registration statements that come in without the certification.

### CHAPTER 478

An Act to require local certification for waste discharge permits into local watershed protection districts.

[S 106] Approved March 31, 2006

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That no application for a Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit authorizing direct or indirect discharge of stormwater runoff from a new municipal solid waste landfill into a local watershed protection district established and designated as such by city ordinance prior to January 1, 2006, shall be considered complete unless it contains certification from the local governing body of the city in which the discharge is to take place, that the discharge is consistent with the city's ordinance establishing and designating the local watershed protection district. This section shall apply to applications for new or modified individual Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits and for new or modified coverage under general Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits. Nothing in this section shall apply to any municipal solid waste landfill in operation on or before January 1, 2006.
- 2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on July 1, 2026.
