11VAC10-120-80. Restrictions on a claimed horse.

When a horse is claimed out of a claiming race other than steeplechase races, the

following restrictions shall apply to the horse for 30 calendar days after the day that the

horse was claimed:

1. The horse may only start in claiming races for a designated price of 25% more than the

amount for which the horse was claimed, except in harness racing a horse may start in

claiming races for any price other than the amount for which the horse was claimed;

2. The horse may not be sold or transferred wholly or in part to another person, except in

another claiming race;

3. The horse may not remain in the same stable or under the control or supervision of its

former owner or trainer, unless reclaimed;

4. The horse may not race elsewhere until after the close of the meeting at which it was

claimed or 30 calendar days, whichever occurs first, except with the permission of the

stewards; and

5. All horses claimed in other jurisdictions and racing in Virginia shall be subject to the

conditions of the claiming regulation in the jurisdiction where the claim was made.
