Section 11VAC10-50-290 of the Virginia Racing Commission's (VRC) regulations contains a fee schedule for permit holders that was amended on January 1, 2010. The VRC was unaware that the fee schedule for permit holders was included in both chapters when it was amended earlier this year.
