The amendment updates these regulations to be consistent with changes that were recently made to the Virginia Hazardous Waste Management Regulations. EPA's Hazardous Waste Generator Improvements Rule (GIR) was adopted, by the Board, as part of Annual Update 2017, Amendment 19 to the Virginia Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, 9VAC20-60. The GIR rule changed the term CESQG to "Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG)". Under this regulatory action, 9VAC20-81 and 9VAC20-130 are being revised to reflect this new term, VSQG, utilized by the federal and state hazardous waste regulations.

In 9VAC20-81-10, the definition of CESQG is being deleted and a definition of very small quantity generator (VSQG) is being added. The term CESQG in the definition of sanitary landfill has been updated with the term VSQG.

In 9VAC20-81-95 D 14, the term CESQG has been updated with the term VSQG.

In 9VAC20-81-250 C 1 c, the term CESQG has been updated with the term VSQG.

In 9VAC20-130-10, the term CESQG in the definition of sanitary landfill has been updated with the term VSQG.

On December 17, 2018, the Waste Management Board took final action to adopt amendments to the Solid Waste Management Regulations (9VAC20-81) and Solid Waste Planning and Recycling Regulations (9VAC20-130) and affirmed that the Board will receive, consider and respond to requests by any interested person at any time with respect to reconsideration or revision. The regulatory action will be filed as soon as possible, consistent with the Administrative Process Act.

The amendments to the regulations are exempt from the state administrative procedures for adoption of regulations by the provisions of § 2.2-4006 A 4 c of the Code of Virginia for regulations amended to meet the requirements of federal law or regulations.
