Regulations of the Board of Funeral Directors and Embalmers refer to resident trainees and traineeship programs in funeral service. Chapter 56 of the 2006 Acts of the Assembly amended Chapter 28 of Title 54.1 of the *Code of Virginia* to change the terminology to a funeral service intern or an internship in funeral service. Accordingly, all such references in Chapters 20 and 40 of the Board's regulations have been amended for conformity with changes in the Code under an exemption in § 2.2-4006 A 4, which grants an exemption if the action is: "Necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved."
