- **SUBJECT:** Regulations Governing the Practice of Physician Assistants 18VAC85-50-10 et seq.

I have reviewed the amendments to the Regulations Governing the Practice of Physician Assistants, 18VAC85-50-10 et seq., which have been amended as emergency regulations pursuant to 2019 Va. Acts Ch. 137. The amendments eliminate supervision of physician assistants by a physician or podiatrist, replacing supervision with collaboration or consultation with a patient care team physician or podiatrist. The Board of Medicine has the statutory authority to amend these regulations under Virginia Code §§ 54.1-2400 and 54.1-2951.1. The proposed amendments are constitutional and do not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
