Pursuant to the 2005 Acts of the Assembly (Chapters 610 and 924), the title of the Board will change on July 1, 2005 from the Board of Nursing Home Administrators to the Board of Long-Term Care Administrators. In sections 10 and 20 of Chapter 10, there are two references to the Board of Nursing Home Administrators that must be changed to Long-Term Care Administrators.

Statement of final agency action

On April 20, 2005, the Board of Nursing Home Administrators acted to amend sections 10 and 20 to change the title of the Board from *Nursing Home Administrators* to *Long-Term Care Administrators*. The action is exempt in the Administrative Process Act under § 2.2-4006 of the Code of Virginia and will become effective on July 1, 2005, the effective date of the legislation.
