**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Update to the Virginia Amusement Device Regulations, 13 VAC 5 –

I have reviewed the Department of Housing and Community Development's proposed update to the Virginia Amusement Device Regulations. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Housing and Community Development, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to §§ 36-98.3 and 2.2-4006(A)(12) of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appeal to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
