SUBJECT: Proposed Regulation to Implement Family Access to Medical Insurance

Security Plan: FAMIS Select

I am in receipt of the attached proposed regulation to create a new health insurance premium assistance component for the Family Access to Medical Insurance Security (FAMIS) program to replace the Employee Sponsored Health Insurance (ESHI) currently in place. You have asked the Office of the Attorney General to review and determine if the Department of Medical Assistance Services ("DMAS") has the legal authority to promulgate the proposed regulation and if the proposed regulation comports with state and federal law.

Based on my review, DMAS has the authority to promulgate this regulation, subject to compliance with the provisions of Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act and has not exceeded that authority.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 32.1-324, 32.1-325, which grants to the Board of Medical Assistance Services the authority to administer and amend the plan for Medical Assistance and authorizes the Director of DMAS to administer and amend the plan for Medical Assistance according to the Board's requirements. The authority for these proposed regulations derives from Chapter 951, Item 324 (L) and Chapter 584 (32.1-351(D), 32.1-351(2) and (3)) of the 2005 Appropriations Act, which mandates DMAS promulgate regulations "to simplify the

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administration of the premium assistance program available to families with children eligible for FAMIS who have access to an employer-sponsored health insurance program."
