
**Minute No. 2 - Stormwater Program Briefings:** The Board received the following reports on the stormwater programs transferred from the Soil and Water Conservation Board to the State Water Control Board:

**Minute No. 3 - Regulatory Actions:** Mr. William K. Norris presented several regulatory actions to the Board to amend the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board regulations that were transferred to the State Water Control Board by Chapters 756 and 793. Mr. Norris briefly reviewed for the Board each regulation and the amendments presented for the Board's consideration.

Based on the Board book material and staff presentation, the Board unanimously:

1. Adopted the amendments to the Virginia Stormwater Management Program (VSMP) Regulations (9VAC25-870); the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction Activities (9VAC25-880); the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (9VAC25-890); the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Designation and Management Regulations (9VAC25-830); the Erosion and Sediment Control Regulations (9VAC25-840); and the Erosion and Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Certification Regulations (9VAC25-850);
2. Withdrew the Soil and Water Conservation Board's Fast-Track action for 4VAC50-60 – Amendment of 4VAC50-60 E of the VSMP Permit Regulations to consider all "approved" TMDLs; and
3. Authorized the regulatory action on the General Permit Regulations for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction Activities to proceed.
