INFORMAL CONFERENCE

Scott Mitchell Davis, MD

Dr. Davis appeared before the committee to respond to its inquiry regarding the possible refusal to issue a license to practice medicine pursuant to Virginia Code 54.1-2915.A(1),(4),(5),(13), (16), (18) and 54.111.A(6) of the Code. Dr. Davis was represented by counsel, Julia Krebs-Markrich.

Upon conclusion of the open session with Dr. Davis, Ms. Maddux moved to convene a closed session pursuant to section 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Davis. Additionally, she moved that William Harp, MD, Alan Heaberlin and Shevaun Roukous attend the closed meeting as their presence would aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and carried.

Upon motion made, seconded and carried, the Committee returned to open session following the procedure for certification of a closed meeting pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.2-3712.

Ms. Maddux moved to recommend to the full Board that Dr. Davis be granted a license to practice medicine and surgery under the conditions that Dr. Davis will be permanently prohibited from practicing pain management; he shall engage in the practice of medicine under the supervision of a preceptor who will submit quarterly

reports to the Board for one year and within 6 months of entry of the Board's Order will complete 10 hours of continuing education in medical ethics and 20 hours in the proper prescribing of medications. The motion was seconded and passed with two votes for the motion and one vote against.
