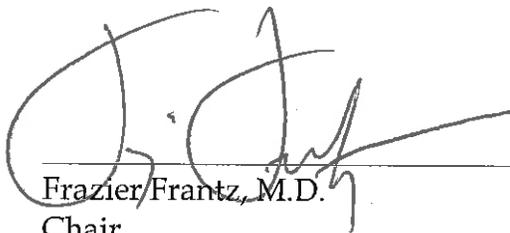
VOTE:

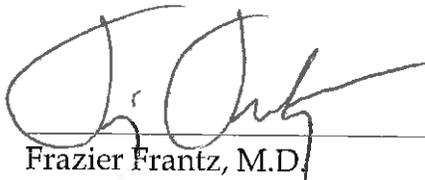

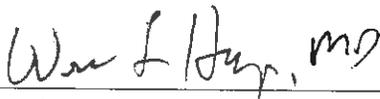
