

**VIRGINIA BOARD OF NURSING
TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL
October 8, 2008**

A telephone conference call meeting of the Virginia Board of Nursing was held October 8, 2008 at 8:30 A.M. The Board members participating in the meeting were Lynne M. Cooper, Citizen Member, President; Florence Jones-Clarke, R.N., M.S.; Brenda Hale, R.N.; Peregrin C. Francisco, R.N., M.S.A.; Evelyn Lindsay, L.P.N.; Judith E. Piersall, R.N., B.S.N.; and G. Maxine Ponn, L.P.N.

Others participating in the meeting were Howard M. Casway, Senior Assistant Attorney General; Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General; Jay P. Douglas, R.N., M.S.M., C.S.A.C., Executive Director; Gloria D. Mitchell, R.N., M.S.N., M.B.A., Deputy Executive Director, Discipline; and Linda Kleiner, R.N., Discipline Case Manager.

The meeting was called to order by Ms. Cooper. With seven members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued nursing practice of Sean Leggett, R.N. 0001-212071 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Piersall moved to summarily suspend the license of Sean Leggett pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of his license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried. Ms. Cooper, Ms. Hale, Ms. Francisco, Ms. Lindsay, Ms. Piersall and Ms. Ponn were in favor of the motion. Ms. Jones-Clarke opposed the motion.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 A.M.
