

Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference

An Informal Fact-Finding Conference (IFF) was convened on April 15, 2004, at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, pursuant to a Notice of Informal Fact-Finding Conference sent by certified mail to John H. Plummer on February 20, 2004. The following individuals participated at the conference: John H. Plummer, Respondent; John S. West, Attorney; Shelby Smith Hill, Investigator; Douglas W. Schroder, Staff Member; and Stanley C. Harris, presiding Board Member.

Background

On March 3, 2003, the Enforcement Division of the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation received a written complaint from David May (May) regarding John H. Plummer (Plummer) on behalf of John H. Plummer & Associates Inc.

The licensing record for the Board revealed Plummer was issued Professional Engineer license number 0402 012466 on June 1, 1981. Plummer is also president of John H. Plummer & Associates, Inc., license number 0407 003174, issued on June 3, 1993.

Summation of Facts

1. On or about January 2003, Plummer moved his business office from 2 North Street, Onancock, Virginia to 4114 Lankford Highway, New Church, Virginia.
2. On March 25, 2003, Plummer notified the Board of the address change by attaching the required DPOR form to his written response to the complaint. Plummer admitted that he did not meet the 30 day requirement, reporting the address change after approximately 90 days after it occurred.
3. Plummer failed to notify the Board, in writing, within thirty (30) days of a change of address.

Conclusion and Recommendation

Count 1: 18 VAC 10-20-660 (Effective March 1, 2002)

Plummer's failure to notify the Board, in writing, within thirty (30) days of a change of address is in violation of Board Regulation 18 VAC 10-20-660. Therefore, I recommend that a monetary penalty of \$200.00 be imposed for a violation of this regulation.

Conclusion and Recommendation

Count 1: 18 VAC 10-20-660 (Effective March 1, 2002)

Plummer's failure to notify the Board, in writing, within thirty (30) days of a change of address is in violation of Board Regulation 18 VAC 10-20-660. Therefore, I recommend that a monetary penalty of \$200.00 be imposed for a violation of this regulation.


