SUBJECT: Regulations Relating to the Certification and Training Requirements of School Security Officers
– 6 VAC 20-240-20 and 6 VAC 20-240-60

In response to a request from the Department of Criminal Justice Services, I have reviewed the proposed regulations, 6 VAC 20-240-20 and 6 VAC 20-240-60, relating to the certification and training requirements of school security officers. Virginia Code § 9.1-102(44) requires the Department to establish compulsory minimum standards for employment and job-entry and in-service training curricula and certification requirements for school security officers. Virginia Code § 9.1-102(1) requires the Department to adopt regulations, pursuant to the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.), for the administration of this chapter. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the proposed regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by Virginia Code §§ 9.1-102(1) and 9.1-102(44) of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
