SUBJECT: Regulations Relating to Private Security Services
(6 VAC 20-171)

In response to a request from the Department of Criminal Justice Services, I have reviewed the proposed regulations, 6 VAC 20-171, relating to Private Security Services. Section 9.1-141 of the Code of Virginia gives the Criminal Justice Services Board the authority to promulgate regulations it deems necessary and appropriate to establish training standards and exemptions relating to persons employed by private security services businesses. Upon review of the aforementioned regulations, I find the proposed regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by § 9.1-141 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
