SUBJECT: Regulations Governing Standards for Recorded Permanent Instruments

I have reviewed the proposed amendments to the *Regulations Governing the Standards for Plats*, 17VAC 15-60-10 *et seq.*, *Regulations Governing the Standards for Recorded Instruments*, 17VAC 15-70-10 *et seq.*, and *Regulations Governing the Standards for Paper Permanent Circuit Court Records*, 17VAC 15-80-10 *et seq.*, and the proposed *Regulations Governing Standards for Recorded Permanent Instruments*, 17VAC 15-61-10 *et seq.* The Library Board has authority to amend and adopt these regulations under Virginia Code § 42.1-82. The proposed amendments are constitutional and do not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
