DECISION:

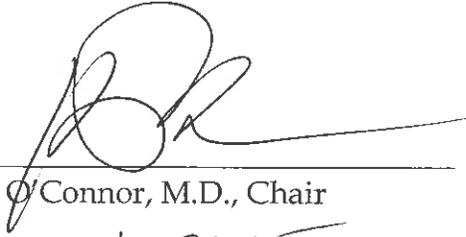
