**DECISION:**

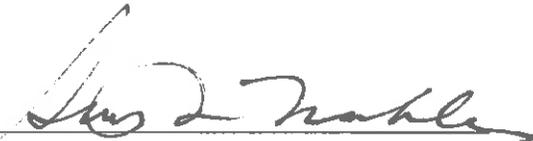
Upon a motion by Dr. Edwards, and duly seconded by Ms. Rowland, the Committee voted to dismiss the matter.

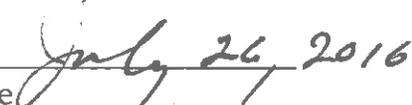
