

**VIRGINIA BOARD OF NURSING
FORMAL HEARINGS
September 18, 2014**

TIME AND PLACE: The meeting of the Virginia Board of Nursing was called to order at 9:01 A.M. on September 18, 2014 in Board Room 4, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico Virginia.

ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM:
With five members of the Board present, a panel was established.

FORMAL HEARINGS: **Mary P. Jones, RN Reinstatement Applicant 0001-138169**
Ms. Jones appeared, accompanied by her husband and her mother.

Amanda Blount, Adjudication Specialist represented the Commonwealth. Mr. Rutkowski was legal counsel for the Board. Medford Howard, court reporter with Crane Snead Reporting, recorded the proceedings.
