

**VIRGINIA BOARD OF NURSING
FORMAL HEARINGS
March 23, 2015**

ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM:
With six members of the Board present, a panel was established.

Wendy Deaner, Adjudication Specialist represented the Commonwealth. Ms. Mitchell was legal counsel for the Board. Juan Ortega, court reporter with Crane Snead Reporting, recorded the proceedings.
