VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 14-411 ISSUED: 01 August 2012

**Subject** Process Safety Management (PSM) Covered Chemical Facilities National Emphasis Program

<u>Purpose</u> This Directive transmits to field personnel policies and procedures for a National

Emphasis Program (NEP) to reduce or eliminate the workplace hazards associated with the catastrophic release of highly hazardous chemicals. This NEP does not apply to Petroleum

refineries (NAICS 32411).

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended

to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not

have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

**Scope** This directive applies to all VOSH personnel.
