VIRGINIA BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICINE POLICY REGARDING DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMS OF VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY

Adopted at the Full Board Meeting of May 21, 2003

Any American Veterinary Medical Association accredited distance education program of veterinary technology with students working in a Virginia licensed veterinary establishment must have a Virginia licensed veterinarian on premises, who is registered as a faculty member of the program in which the student is enrolled, supervising the student.

All preceptorship programs must meet the requirements of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
