FORMAL HEARING**

**TIME AND PLACE:** A meeting of the Virginia Board of Dentistry convened on December 7, 2006, at 10:35 a.m. at the Department of Health Professions, Richmond, Virginia.

**QUORUM:** With seven members present, a quorum was established.

**DARRYL D. DETTMANN,

Case No. 107168** Darryl D. Dettmann, D.D.S. appeared without counsel, to discuss his application for licensure by credentials to practice dentistry in the Commonwealth of Virginia and allegations that grounds may exist to deny him issuance of a license, in that, he:

1. failed to meet the requirements of § 54.1-2709.B(iv) and (v) of the Code, as he did not provide documentation in connection with his Application to corroborate that he had completed and passed a clinical examination acceptable to the Board involving live patient care, in violation of § 54.1-2709.C(i) of the

Code, and 18 VAC 60-20-71(4) of the Regulations of the Board of Dentistry; and

2. did not provide documentation in connection with his Application to show that he had been in continuous clinical practice, of at least six hundred (600) hours annually, for five (5) of the last six (6) years preceding his application, in violation of § 54.1-2709.C(v) of the Code and 18 VAC 60-20-71(6) [currently 18 VAC 60-20-71(7), *effective August 23, 2006*] of the Regulations of the Board of Dentistry.

The Board received Dr. Dettmann's testimony and discussed his application with him.

**Closed Meeting:**

Dr. Snyder moved that the Board convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711 (A) (28) of the Code of Virginia to deliberate in reaching a decision in the matter of Darryl D. Dettmann, D.D.S. Additionally, Dr. Snyder moved that Board Counsel, Howard Casway, and Board staff, Sandra Reen and Cheri Emma-Leigh attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and passed.

**Reconvene:**

Dr. Snyder moved to certify that only public matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting and only public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered by the Board. The motion was seconded and passed.

The Board reconvened in open session pursuant to § 2.2-3712(D) of the Code.

**Decision:**

Mr. Casway read the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law adopted by the Board as follows:

1. Dr. Dettmann currently holds a Dental Teacher license; and
2. Dr. Dettmann does not meet the requirement of § 54.1-2709.C(v) of the Code and 18 VAC 60-20-71(6) [currently 18 VAC 60-20-71(7), *effective*

*August 23, 2006]* of the Regulations of the Board of Dentistry, in that, he did not provide documentation in connection with his Application to show that he had been in continuous clinical practice, of at least six hundred (600) hours annually, for five (5) of the last six (6) years preceding his application.

Mr. Casway reported that it is the decision of the Board to deny Dr. Dettmann's Application for Licensure by Credentials.

Dr. Gokli moved to adopt the Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law and the decision of the Board as read by Mr. Casway. The motion was seconded and passed.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

With all business concluded, the Board adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
