Marjorie Clark and Florence Daniels.



The meeting was called to order at 8:35 a.m. by Florence Daniels. Ms. Hayes informed the sub-committee members of the current Real Estate Board caseload. Ms. Hayes briefly discussed and answered questions regarding the cases on the agenda. Ms. Hayes reviewed and distributed the draft motion statements to the sub-committee members. Ms. Hayes also discussed the reconsideration policy and advised the sub-committee members of one change made to the draft policy. Mrs. Scovill asked how the public would be made aware of the new policy and suggested adding information pertaining to the new policy to the fair housing office's website. Ms. Hayes also suggested adding a paragraph to the notification letters advising parties of the policy.

Ms. Hayes recommended the board defer action on HOME's request for reconsideration in the HOME v. Gerner case because all parties were not notified timely. that this matter would be on today's agenda. Ms. Clark concurred and added that because of her relationship with the respondent she hoped Mr. Key would be notified if the matter would be on the next agenda in hopes that he can attend the meeting.
