The meeting of the Credentials Committee convened at 2:00pm.

**INTERVIEWS**

**WAGIH MANDO, MD**

Wagih Mando, MD was scheduled to appear before the Credentials Committee to respond to its inquiry regarding the possible refusal to issue a license to practice medicine pursuant to Virginia Code section 54.1-2915(A). Dr. Mando did not show for his scheduled conference and did not notify the board in advance that he would not attend. After a thorough review of the evidence before it, Dr. Mosby moved to deny Dr. Mando's request for a license based on the allegations cited in the notice dated December 27, 2005. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

**JORDAN PAUL WEISS, MD**

Jordan Paul Weiss, MD, being duly sworn, appeared before the Committee to respond to its inquiry regarding the possible refusal to issue a license to practice medicine pursuant to Virginia Code Section 54.1-2915.A(5). Upon conclusion of the hearing, Dr. Piness entertained motions.

Dr. Mosby moved to convene a closed meeting pursuant to section 2.2-3711A(28) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Weiss. Additionally, he moved that, Ola Powers, Dr. Harp and Leigh Kiczales attend the closed meeting because their presence would aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and carried. Upon motion made, seconded and carried, the Committee returned to open session following the procedure for certification of an executive meeting pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.2-3712.

The Committee found that Dr. Weiss did not meet the requirements for licensure as established by Sections 54.1-2915.A(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"). Based on that finding, Dr. Mosby moved to deny Dr. Weiss' application for a license. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

### **DOUGLAS KWOK CHAN, MD**

Douglas Kwok Chan, MD was scheduled to appear before the Credentials Committee to respond to its inquiry regarding the possible refusal to issue a license to practice medicine pursuant to Virginia Code Section 54.1-2915(A)(4). Dr. Chan did not show for his scheduled conference and did not notify the Board in advance that he would not attend. After a thorough review of the evidence before it, Dr. Lambert moved to deny Dr. Chan's request for a license based on the allegations cited in the notice dated December 27, 2005. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
