

**VIRGINIA BOARD OF NURSING
TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL
May 3, 2011**

A telephone conference call meeting of the Virginia Board of Nursing was held May 3, 2011 at 8:30 A.M. The Board members participating in the meeting were Patricia M. Selig, R.N., F.N.P., Ph.D., President; Peregrin Francisco, R.N., M.S.A.; Joyce A. Hahn, Ph.D., APRN, NEA-BC; Louise D. Harz, Citizen Member; Judith E. Piersall, R.N., B.S.N.; Karen K. Schultz, Ph.D., M.B.A, Citizen Member; William Traynham, L. P.N. Evelyn Lindsay, L.P.N. joined later.

Others participating in the meeting were Howard M. Casway, Senior Assistant Attorney General; Corie Tillman Wolf, Assistant Attorney General; James Schliessmann, Assistant Attorney General; Jay P. Douglas, R.N., M.S.M., C.S.A.C., Executive Director; Gloria D. Mitchell, R.N., M.S.N., M.B.A., Deputy Executive Director; Jodi P. Power, R.N., J.D., Deputy Executive Director; David Kazzie, Senior Adjudication Specialist; and James Rutkowski, Senior Adjudication Specialist.

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Selig. With seven members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

Corie Tillman Wolf, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued nurse aide practice of Shelia Beard, C.N.A. 1401-037156, may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Hartz moved to summarily suspend the nurse aide certificate of Shelia Beard pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for revocation of her certificate with a finding of abuse in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Ms. Lindsay joined the call for a total of eight board members participating.

James Schliessmann, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued n practice of Chana Molini, R.N. 0001-180774, may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Piersall moved to summarily suspend the license of Chana Molini, R.N. pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 A.M.
