Corie E. Tillman Wolf, Assistant Attorney General, prosecuted the case with the assistance of Mykl D. Egan, DHP Adjudication Specialist.

Martha W. Miller, DHP Senior Investigator; Lloyd Havens, Store Manager, CVS/pharmacy #1836; and Glenn Bolyard,

CVS Pharmacy supervisor, testified on behalf of the Commonwealth.

A formal hearing was held in the matter of Yannick O. Agyare following the summary suspension of his pharmacy technician registration on June 9, 2011, and to discuss allegations that he may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy technicians in Virginia.

The panel proceeded in Mr. Agyare's absence as the Notice of Formal Hearing dated June 9, 2011, was mailed to his legal address of record, both by regular and certified mail.
