Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

**RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

Upon a motion by Dr. Arnold, and duly seconded by Dr. Tuck the Committee voted to exonerate Dr. Murray.

The Committee adjourned at 9:54 a.m.


