Re: Determination of Candidate Qualifications

Applicable Code Section:

Va. Code § 24.2-503 - The written statements of qualification and economic interests shall be filed by (i) primary candidates not later than the filing deadline for the primary, (ii) all other candidates for city and town offices to be filled at a May general election by 7:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday in March, (iii) candidates in special elections by the time of qualifying as a candidate, and (iv) all other candidates by 7:00 p.m. on the second Tuesday in June.

A statement shall be deemed to be timely filed if it is mailed postage prepaid to the appropriate office by registered or certified mail and if the official receipt therefor, which shall be exhibited on demand, shows mailing within the prescribed time limits.

The State Board may grant an extension of any deadline for filing either or both written statements and shall notify all candidates who have not filed their statements of the extension. Any extension shall be granted for a fixed period of time of ten days from the date of the mailing of the notice of the extension.

Va. Code § 24.2-511.A – "The state, district, or other appropriate party chairman shall certify the name of any candidate who has been nominated by his party by a method other than a primary for any office to be elected by the qualified voters of (i) the Commonwealth at large, (ii) a congressional district or a General Assembly district, or (iii) political subdivisions jointly electing a shared constitutional officer, along with the date of the nomination of the candidate, to the State Board not later than five days after the last day for nominations to be made. The State Board shall notify the general registrars of the names of the candidates to appear on the ballot for such offices."

Background:

After publicly posting a list of candidates for Virginia House of Delegates, a local General Registrar contacted the Department of Elections about the lack of a Republican candidate for the House of Delgates 30th District (HOD-30). Upon examination of the records, it was determined that the Department had not received a Party Certification of Non-Primary Candidate (ELECT-511) form nor had it received any candidate paperwork (Certificate of Candidate Qualification (SBE-501) or Statement of Economic Interests (SOEI)) from any Republican candidates in HOD-30. The attached documents related to Issue #1 are presented for the Board's consideration of accepting the ELECT-511 after the June 17, 2019 deadline. In the attachments presented to the Board at the July 11 meeting, ELECT inadvertently omitted a letter from Mr. Chris Marston, General Counsel for the Republican Party of Virginia. That letter is included with the attachments to this memo.

Dear Commissioner Piper,

I write regarding the Republican nomination of Nick J. Freitas for the 30th District in the House of Delegates. I understand that the Department did not timely receive the ELECT-511 Form from Bruce Kay, the chairman of the Legislative District Committee for that district. I know that you have received correspondence from representatives of Del. Freitas, including an affidavit from Chairman Kay.

All of the appropriate procedures under the Plan of Organization for the Republican Party of Virginia were followed by Chairman Kay and Del. Freitas in the nominating process and Del. Freitas is the Republican nominee for the 30th District.

The Legislative District Committee selected a convention as the method of nomination for the District and the convention was called for April 27. Del. Freitas was the only candidate to file for the nomination. Pursuant to the call for the convention, the convention was cancelled, and Del. Freitas became the nominee of the Party. On March 9, Chairman Kay notified John Findlay, the Party's Executive Director, so that notice of the convention cancellation could be provided on our website. On May 7, Chairman Kay sent the ELECT-511 Form to the Department certifying Del. Freitas as the nominee. Unfortunately, it appears that the form was never received due to e-mail issues. Nevertheless, the Republican Party of Virginia requests that the State Board of Elections and the Department treat Nick J. Freitas as the Republican nominee and direct that his name be printed on the ballots in the 30th District.

I also want to express my regret over this and several other challenges with deadlines for determining the method of nomination as well as certifying nominees this year. I stand ready to work with the Department in future elections to ensure that the Republican Party of Virginia does everything it can to assist in ensuring compliance with

relevant filing requirements and deadlines. I understand the challenge of over 250 different chairs in the cities, counties, and legislative districts responsible for filing information with the Department. I commend your staff for the excellent work they have done in managing the process. I look forward to working with them to make the process easier to manage in future elections.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter.
