Ms. Yeatts explained the purpose of the restricted volunteer license and asked if it would apply to licensed midwives. The board agreed that the restricted volunteer license would not apply and no action was necessary.

#4. Report of Ad Hoc Committee on Possession and Administration of controlled Substances by Licensed Midwives

Dr. Neiman gave an overview of the Ad Hoc Committee meeting. Ms. Payne expressed concern regarding the issue of safety to the public. It was felt that the law needs to be addressed first before further discussion on how possession and administration can happen. Dr. Harp commented on the necessity of the need for documented data to present to the full Board. Dr. Neiman gave suggestions to possibly assist the Advisory board to present their case to the full Board. Dr. Harp also commented that the Board may not act at this time, but to preserve the recommendation of the Ad Hoc Committee. No action was taken.

#5. Report on Status of Regulations – Replacement of Emergency Regulations

Ms. Yeatts explained the status of the Emergency Regulations.
