Discussion: Dr. Dosik appeared before the Committee in person in

accordance with a Notice of Informal Conference dated June 21, 2017. Dr. Dosik was not represented by legal counsel. The Committee fully discussed the allegations

Closed Session: Dr. Roffis moved that the Committee convene a closed

meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter regarding Allan G. Dosik, O.D. Additionally, Dr. Roffis moved that Ms. Blount and Ms. Weiss attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was

seconded and carried unanimously.

Reconvene: Dr. Roffis moved that the Committee certify that it

heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and
