#### APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES

Approval of the February 28 meeting minutes was deferred to the next meeting. Absent a quorum in the primary Richmond location, no motions or votes could be taken.

## **VOWDA BUSINESS**

<u>SCC Letter – VOWDA Support of Coastal Virginia Offshore Wind Project (CVOW)</u>: Discussions focused on minor format changes and the need to revisit the letter content once the Dominion filing occurs after July 1, 2018. Emphasis should also be placed on "approval of the CVOW project" and not so much on the "approval of cost recovery".

BOEM Request for Feedback (RFF) – VOWDA Comments on Proposed Path Forward of Future Offshore Renewable Energy Leasing on the Atlantic OCS: Virginia meets many of BOEM's leasing criteria, although challenges still exist (e.g., maritime shipping, Wallop Island rocket launches, oil and gas activities). There still remains an area large enough to double/triple Virginia's current Wind Energy Area. The proposed VOWDA comment letter will be rewritten and submitted to BOEM by DMME by the May 21, 2018, deadline since no vote could be taken by the Authority.

**2018 Work Plan Updates:** DE Director Al Christopher briefed the members on the considerable progress made by the task groups assigned to work on each Work Plan task. There was discussion on the possibility of combining or merging some tasks.

## **DMME UPDATES**

Al Christopher reported on the following items.

- April 26 Port of Virginia tour with potential OSW industry representatives.
- Supply Chain Work Plan being developed.
- Open invitation to BOEM to tour the Port of Virginia in conjunction with a state/federal agencies meeting planned on CVOW, to include a power export cable site tour.
- Chair Bondareff will moderate a panel on Virginia/North Carolina offshore wind efforts at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual U.S. Offshore Wind Conference being hosted by NewEnergyUpdate of the UK in Boston on June 7-8.
- May 9 BOEM meeting in Newark, NJ; DMME will probably not be in attendance.
