H. Other Business

- 1. At its March 15, 2012, meeting, the Board approved requiring a standard Board-approved examination, as a condition for approval, for all Residential Standard Agency (RSA) distance learning courses and directed the Committee to study and recommend a standard examination for all distance learning RSA courses at its May 21, 2012, meeting. The Committee reviewed and recommended approval of the twenty exam questions in the Virginia Association of Realtors Board-approved RSA-course (Course Number 64123) as the standard Board-approved examination for all Board-approved RSA distance learning courses.
- 2. The Committee considered the question, "Do active licensees whose license is affiliated with a referral company practice residential real estate?" Board staff received many questions from these licensees inquiring as to whether they can seek a waiver from having to complete the three-hour Residential Standard Agency course. The Committee determined these active licensees do practice residential real estate and must complete the RSA course.
- 3. The Committee considered the following question from an approved education provider: "Will Board-approved three-hour Residential Standard Agency courses meet the three-hour Virginia Agency Law Post License Education course requirement that is part of the new post license education 30-hour curriculum?" The Committee determined that each course application must be considered on an individual basis, but it is likely that a course approved for three hours of Residential Standard Agency could also be approved for three hours of Virginia Agency Law when the new Post License Education program for new salespersons goes into effect.

Deputy Director Mark Courtney informed the Committee that Board staff is working on the "New Post License Education Curriculum Guidance Document" that will likely be brought before the Board for review and approval at its July 12, 2012, meeting. The phase out of the current PLE program and the phase in of the new PLE program must be coordinated with the implementation of the Board's new electronic information system before the final language for the Guidance Document can be drafted.
