TAC Meeting Minutes:

The purpose of this meeting was to present to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) an overview of the process that has been used to develop draft bacteria TMDLs for 14 watersheds within the Mattaponi project area. The meeting started with introductions of all attendees. DEQ presented an overview of Virginia's water quality standards; the project area and its impairments for the recreation use due to *E. coli* bacteria; an overview of the modeling process used for this project; and examples of the TMDL tables that will be included in the draft TMDL report.

DEQ presented posters of the draft TMDL allocations for each of the 14 watersheds included in the project as well as a project map so that members of the TAC could review the information for their geographic area of interest. Some TAC members expressed concern that they did not provide input for the compilation of livestock inventories for the project; DEQ agreed to send an email follow-up with the draft livestock inventories to the applicable TAC members. Additionally, DEQ agreed to send to the applicable TAC members the shapefiles of the watershed boundaries.

DEQ presented the schedule for public meetings for this project: November 4, 2015, at the Snow Library in Spotsylvania and November 9, 2015, at the Bowling Green Town Hall; the public comment period will end on December 8, 2015. There was discussion about how DEQ announces the public meetings; DEQ explained that meeting announcement flyers have been distributed to local libraries; additionally, the meeting announcement flyer was distributed to the TAC via email for them to share with stakeholders and paper copies of the flyer were available at this TAC meeting.
