Public Comment

Mr. DeBoer welcomed the Board members and presented the Director's Jay W. DeBoer, Report. The General Assembly is nearing adjournment with the House and Director's Report Senate still in negotiations over the final budget. There is a "capturing" of DPOR cash balance reserves to be applied to the general fund.

There are 209 filled positions within DPOR with 65% staff working nonregular hours; 43% telecommuting on a regular basis; and 12% telecommuting sometime.

Resignation of Julie M. Clifford

The new office construction on the first floor is complete with new and improved DPOR signage for the Customer Service area, which is now located on the 1st floor.

EAGLES is ready for the 2nd phase of release with the Board for Contractors beginning testing today. The 3rd phase is scheduled for release in 2012 with Real Estate and some smaller boards.

Discussion followed when Ms. Buchwald asked how to inform regulants that fees are going to the general fund, as licensees' fees are generally collected for regulation and no other purpose. Mr. DeBoer explained the budget document is public.

Mary Broz-Vaughan, Director of Communications, Legislation, and Consumer Education, gave the Board members an update on the 2010 General Assembly Session. Ms. Broz-Vaughan informed the members that Legislative there were more than 2800 bills introduced this session, and DPOR tracked more than 65 bills. Ms. Broz-Vaughan reviewed HB 1219, HB 1272, HB 1265, HB 596, and SB 665. Ms. Broz-Vaughan also noted HB 792/SB 474 will allow DPOR Boards to issue temporary 45-day licenses to applicants licensed in another state, while their application for a permanent license is in This supports Governor McDonnell's Job Creation/Economic process. Mr. Jenkins conducted his demonstration with the assistance of Mr. DeBoer.
