His leadership philosophy – founded on integrity, trust and respect – focuses on allocating resources while building individual and organizational capabilities, providing exceptional customer service (both internally and externally), protecting consumers, and creating jobs for our licensees in their chosen fields. Mr. Dixon further briefed the Board with the Governor's update wherein Governor McDonnell offered thanks to each agency for their service and commitment. The Governor also reviewed his mission, goals, and policies and procedures for the agency and presented the Governor's Reform Commission.

Mr. Dixon also briefed the Board on the Secretary of Commerce and Trade's report of the development of a new strategic plan for DPOR for the next three years; a focus on jobs creation particularly in economically distressed areas; and an overseas trade mission.

Mr. Dixon then presented a regulatory and fee adjustment update noting approved fee increases for Barbers and Cosmetology and Hearing Aid Specialists, and CIC Ombudsman regulations approval.

An EAGLES briefing followed noting that we are in the third year of a seven-year program update.

Ms. Cake asked for an update regarding the Chinese Drywall Task Force. Mr. Dixon and Mr. Courtney both addressed the issue of Chinese drywall noting that this situation is continually being watched and monitored. At this point, it is a serious ongoing issue that has no solution yet.
