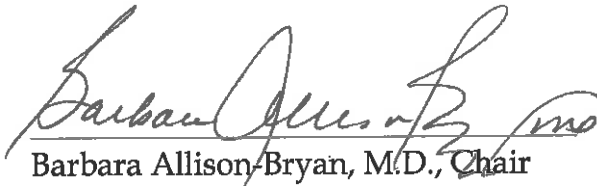
VOTE:

The vote was unanimous.

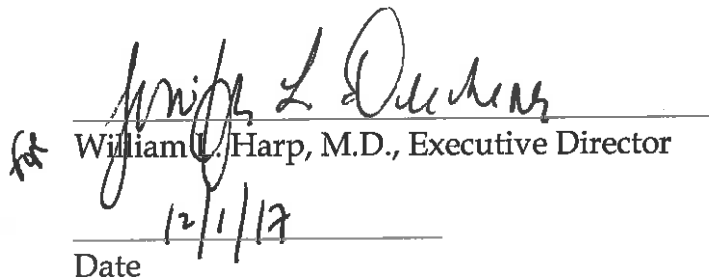
ADJOURNMENT:

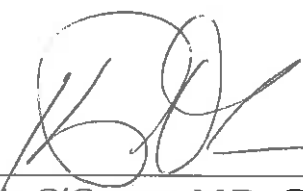

The Committee adjourned at 1:54 p.m.

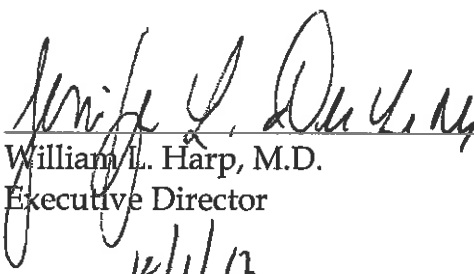
