- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:03 a.m.

- DISCUSSION:** Dr. Jones appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated November 2, 2017. Dr. Jones was not represented by counsel.
- The Committee fully discussed the allegations in the Notice with Dr. Jones.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Koziol, and duly seconded by Dr. Archer, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Jones. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Koziol, and duly seconded by Dr. Archer, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to issue Dr. Jones a reprimand and place his license on indefinite probation with terms and conditions and restricted from prescribing Schedule II and III drugs.

The vote was unanimous.


ADJOURNMENT:

The Committee adjourned at 11:48 a.m.




