CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:19 a.m.

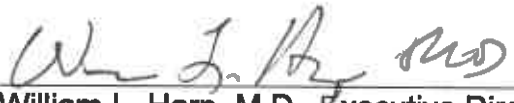
ADJOURNMENT: The Committee adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
