Further, suspend her practical nursing license for six months after which her license will be reinstated and placed on indefinite probation for two years of active employment as a practical nursing with terms and conditions and require Ms. Williams to complete four National Council of State Boards of Nursing online courses: "Professional Accountability and Legal Liability for Nurses"; "Righting a Wrong, Ethics and Professionalism in Nursing"; "Sharpening Critical Thinking Skills for Competence Nursing Practice"; and "Disciplinary Actions, What Every Nurse Should Know" within six months of entry of the order. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

This decision shall be effective upon the entry by the Board of a written Order stating the findings, conclusions, and decision of this formal hearing panel.
