Crane-Snead and Associates recorded the proceedings.

Denise Sexton, Senior Investigator, Department of Health Professions and Cathy Ward, Case Manager, Health Practitioners Monitoring Program were present

and testified.

CLOSED MEETING: Dr. McDonough moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and

Medicine and the Board of Nursing convene a closed meeting pursuant to Section 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the *Code of Virginia* at 12:03 P.M. for the purpose to reach a decision in the matter of Ms. Cotellese. Additionally, Dr. McDonough moved that Ms. Douglas, Ms. Mitchell-Lively, Ms. Davis and Ms.

Barrett attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary, and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

RECONVENTION:

The Committee reconvened in open session at 12:40 P.M.

Dr. McDonough moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine and the Board of Nursing certify that it heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Ms. Caliwagan moved that the Board of Nursing accept the findings of fact and conclusions of law as presented by Ms. Jones and amended by the Board. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Dr. Mackler moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine accept the findings of fact and conclusions of law as presented by Ms. Jones and amended by the Committee. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

ACTION:

Ms. Lindsay moved that the Board of Nursing issue an order of reprimand to Mary Ellen Cotellese, continue her registered nursing license on indefinite suspension, but stay the suspension contingent upon re-entry into the Health Practitioners Monitoring Program and remaining in compliance with the Program and to complete a Board approved refresher course prior to returning to practice as a registered nurse. The motion was seconded and carried. Ms. Caliwagan, Ms. Hershkowitz, Ms. Lindsay and Dr. McDonough were in favor of the motion. Ms. Gerardo opposed the motion.

Dr. Mackler moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine issue an order of reprimand to Mary Ellen Cotellese, continue her nurse practitioner license on indefinite suspension, but stay the suspension contingent upon re-entry into the Health Practitioners Monitoring Program and remaining in compliance with the Program and that Ms. Cotellese provide evidence of continued competence and national certification. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
