Curriculum Changes

VCCS Concept Based Core Curriculum, RN Programs

Charles Smith, MS, RN, Dean, Rappahannock Community College; Patricia Lisk, RN, Ph.D, Dean, Germanna Community College; Tammy Colatruglio, MSN, RN, Director, John Tyler Community College; Elaine Beaupre, RN, M.Ed, MSN, CNE, Director, J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, and Dr. Daniel Lewis, Director of Educational Programs and Policy, VCCS System Office were in attendance.

Representatives presented information on the development and implementation of the VCCS Concept Based Common Curriculum for registered nurses. Representatives stated that 19 Virginia community college nursing programs participated in the process and that 4 community colleges will participate in the initial controlled roll out. Those community colleges are Rappahannock Community College, Reynolds Community College, Germanna Community College and John Tyler Community College.

Representatives reported that this shared curriculum has been contemplated for many years however it was not until 2014 that consensus was reached and the committee started meeting. The colleges acknowledged Dr. Saxby's leadership and support when these meetings convened in 2014 and that Ms. Ridout's attendance at committee meetings and invaluable input contributed greatly to the final product.

Key points shared by the representatives include:

- Focus is on seamless progression
- Collaboration between colleges, faculty and leadership and Board of Nursing was critical

Key Success factors were:

- The concepts were thoroughly researched
- Partnerships with 4 year colleges that deliver RN to BSN programs are in place
- Outcomes include a predictable product, ability of students to transfer between community colleges and the content is now presented in a way that develops thinking skills.

Recommend to approve the direct care component of Chamberlain College's Global Health Education Program contingent upon compliance with Virginia regulations including faculty to student ratios in direct care.
