The meeting was called to order by Dr. Hahn. With nine members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

James Scheleissmann, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the continued practice of nursing by Lea Lorraine New, RN 0001- 235280 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Holmes moved to summarily suspend the right to renew the nursing license of Lea Lorraine New pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of his certificate in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

James Scheleissmann, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the nursing practice of Alice Bradshaw, RN 0001- 246249 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Dr. McDonough moved to summarily suspend the practical nursing license of Alice Bradshaw, pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 A.M.
