#### BOARD FOR BRANCH PILOTS MEETING MINUTES

The Virginia Board for Branch Pilots met on Thursday, June 15, 2017, at the Virginia Port Authority, 600 World Trade Center, Norfolk, Virginia, with the following members present:

There was no representative present from the Office of the Attorney General.

Finding a quorum of the Board present, Captain Cofer, Vice President, called the meeting to order at 10:45 a.m.

Call to Order

Ms. Nosbisch advised the Board of the emergency evacuation procedures.

Safety Evacuation Instructions

Mr. Host moved to approve the agenda. Ms. Piersall seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by Messrs., Mme. and Captains: Callis, Chisman, Cofer, Host, Morgan, and Piersall.

Approval of Agenda

Ms. Piersall moved to approve the minutes from the March 30, 2017, Board meeting. Captain Callis seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by Messrs., Mme. and Captains: Callis, Chisman, Cofer, Host, Morgan, and Piersall.

Approval of Minutes

There were no public comments. However, Captain Cofer introduced to the Board retired Branch Pilot Captain George Watkins and Branch Pilot Greg Willson who were in attendance at the meeting.

Public Comment Period

Greg Willson answered oral questions related to the extension of route. The subjects included channel depths beyond the Deepwater Terminal, characteristics of the river with regard to vessel placement approaching turns, usage of turning basin, local traffic and desired meeting positions, pier and

dock descriptions, safe anchoring positions, safe anchoring methods in a narrow channel, adverse weather conditions including freshets, and safe vessel speed. Captain Callis moved that Captain Willson be granted an extension of route from City Point to Richmond upon the James River. Captain Chisman seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by Messrs., Mme. and Captains: Callis, Chisman, Cofer, Host, Morgan, and Piersall.

Captain Cofer presented the 2018 meetings dates. Ms. Piersall moved to adopt the following meeting and examination dates for 2018.

Mr. Host seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by Messrs., Mme. and Captains: Callis, Chisman, Cofer, Host, Morgan, and Piersall.

Financial statements were provided for informational purposes. Ms. Nosbisch stated she confers with the Director of Financial Services annually and there are no anticipated fee increases in the foreseeable future for licensed Branch Pilots.

Financial Statements

By consensus, the Board agreed to table this item until the meeting on September 15, 2017.

Maritime Symposium Update

Ms. Nosbisch recognized National Maritime Day which was May 22nd. The Branch Pilots were sent an email and the recognized day was posted on DPOR's website. Ms. Nosbisch thanked the profession for their service to the Board. Captain Cofer stated that he and Captain Chisman attended the commemorative wreath-laying ceremony; Port of Virginia's CEO and executive director, John F. Reinhart, participated.

Captain Cofer stated that at the last meeting, he presented information on increasing the Limited Branch Pilots Tonnage and Draft Limitation for further

consideration for approval at this meeting. Additional statistics were assessed by the Board, and Captain Chisman made the following recommendations for the Board's consideration.

**Draft Limitation** Review

Alpha 16,000gt/25' to 21,000gt/27'maximum draft Bravo 25,000gt/28' to 33,000/30' maximum draft Charlie 32,000/32' to 38,000gt/33' maximum draft Delta 38,000gt/34' to 44,000gt/35' maximum draft Echo 42,000gt/36' to 52,000gt/37' maximum draft Foxtrot 46.000gt/40' to 57.000gt/41' maximum draft Golf 55,000/42' to 68,000gt/43' maximum draft Hotel 64,000gt/46' to 75,000gt/46' maximum draft

He stated the increase is consistent with what the Board approved in 2006 and 2011. After further review, discussion and consideration of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Commonwealth, Ms. Piersall moved to adopt the proposed increases in gross tonnage and draft for the limited branch pilot licenses. Mr. Host seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by Messrs. and Captains: Callis, Chisman, Cofer, Host, Morgan and Piersall.

Captain Chisman reported that all Branch pilots have attended Ultra Large Container Vessel (ULCV) training at the Maritime Pilots Institute in Covington, Louisiana. The instructor came to Virginia and rode inbound on a ULCV to get data for his ship simulator. Bill Burket, Director of the Maritime Incident Response Team (MIRT), emergency first responder, was permitted to familiarize himself with the ship. There has been tremendous collaboration with all entities involved with the changing dynamic of the port.

There was general discussion that the volume of cargo is up but the number of Other Business ships is down because of the size of the ships. The ULCVs are not routinely arriving in the middle of the night as anticipated which causes port congestion.

Captain Cofer stated that Edgar Massenburg passed away. He served on the Board for Branch Pilots and was a tremendous mentor to him. Captain Cofer expressed his gratitude and appreciation for Mr. Massenburg's loyalty and dedication to the state piloting service of the Commonwealth. He will be missed.

Ms. Nosbisch stated the news reported that the Port of Charleston had a suspected incident that was unfounded.

Ms. Nosbisch stated she will be out of the office on extended medical leave. and Ms. Brooks will be acting Executive Director beginning June 26, 2017.
