The Board has made a regulatory change which is exempt from provisions of the Administrative Process Act. In order to reduce an accumulated surplus in the budget of the Board of Counseling, a one-time reduction in renewal fees has been adopted for the renewal due June 30, 2007. The renewal fee for licensed professional counselors, marriage and family therapists and licensed substance abuse treatment providers will be reduced for the annual renewal from \$105 to \$52; for substance abuse counselors and rehabilitation providers, the renewal fee will be reduced from \$55 to \$27; and for substance abuse counseling assistants, the renewal fee will be reduced from \$40 to \$20.

This action is exempt from the Virginia Administrative Process Act in § 2.2-4006 A 7: "Regulations of the regulatory boards served by (i) the Department of Labor and Industry pursuant to Title 40.1 and (ii) the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation or the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Title 54.1 that are limited to reducing fees charged to regulants and applicants."

On February 9, 2007, the Board of Counseling adopted an exempt action to amend Chapter 20 - Regulations Governing the Practice of Counseling; Chapter 30 - Regulations Governing the Certification of Substance Abuse Counselors and Substance Abuse Counseling Assistants; Chapter 40 - Regulations Governing the Certification of Rehabilitation Providers; Chapter 50 - Regulations Governing The Practice Of Marriage And Family Therapy; and Chapter 60 - Regulations Governing The Practice Of Licensed Substance Abuse Treatment Practitioners to reduce the renewal fee for the June 30, 2007 renewal by ½ the amount.
