Re: Proposed Regulation 8 VAC 20-90-10 et. seq. Procedure for Adjusting Grievances

(Action 4027/Stage 7561)

I have reviewed the proposed regulations stated above to determine whether the State Board of Education (Board) has the authority to promulgate the regulations and if the proposed regulations comport with applicable state law. Pursuant to the *Code of Virginia* §22.1-16, the Board has authority to promulgate regulations to carry out its statutory powers and duties. Additionally, pursuant to the *Code of Virginia* §22.1-308, the Board has authority to prescribe by regulation a grievance procedure for teachers.

It is this Office's view that the Board has the authority to promulgate this proposed regulation, subject to compliance with the provisions of Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act and Virginia Office of the Governor Executive Order 17 (2014), and has not exceeded that authority.
