

**VIRGINIA BOARD OF NURSING
TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL
April 8, 2008**

A telephone conference call meeting of the Virginia Board of Nursing was held April 8, 2008 at 9:00 A.M. The meeting was called to order by Ms. Jones-Clarke. With nine members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

James Schliessmann, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the continued nursing practice of Aimee Sibal, L.P.N., 0002-067277 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Hale moved to summarily suspend the license of Aimee Sibal, L.P.N. pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

James Schliessmann, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the continued nursing practice of Jennifer Riddell, R.N. 0001-102786 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Dr. Selig moved to summarily suspend the license of Jennifer Riddell, R.N. pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:18 A.M.
