TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL
February 9, 2010

A telephone conference call meeting of the Virginia Board of Nursing was held February 9, 2010 at 8:45 A.M. The Board members participating in the meeting were Florence Jones-Clarke, R.N., M.S., Vice President; Judith E. Piersall, R.N., B.S.N.; Brenda Hale, R.N.; Karen Schultz, M.B.A.; Ph.D, Citizen Member; Lynne M. Cooper, Citizen Member; William Traynham, L.P.N.; and Patricia Lane, R.N., B.S.N.

Others participating in the meeting were Howard M. Casway, Senior Assistant Attorney General; Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General; Jodi P. Power, R.N., J.D., Deputy Executive Director; Brenda Krohn, R.N., M.S., Deputy Executive Director; Linda Kleiner, R.N., Discipline Case Manager; Anne Joseph, Deputy Director, Administrative Proceedings Division; and Jim Rutkowski, Adjudication Specialist.

The meeting was called to order by Ms. Jones-Clarke. With seven members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued nursing practice of Sunnye Miller, R.N. 0001-193149 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Mr. Traynham moved to summarily suspend the professional nursing license of Sunnye Miller pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 A.M.
