I have reviewed the above-referenced regulations. It is my opinion that the Safety and Health Codes Board has authority to promulgate such amendments under applicable law, including Chapter 3 of Title 40.1 of the Code of Virginia.

Further, based upon your agency's representations, it is my opinion that under Virginia Code § 2.2-4006.A.4(c) the regulations are excluded from Article 2 of the Virginia Administrative Process Act because they are necessary to meet the requirements of federal law or regulations.
